Overview of Position: Under direction of the Maintenance Supervisor, performs a wide variety of beginning level and unskilled work related within the field of construction and maintenance activities of an irrigation delivery system.

Some Essential Duties include:

- Performs unskilled tasks while learning semi-skilled tasks in the construction, repair and maintenance of irrigation facilities;
- Sprays and burns ditches and canals;
- Operates equipment such as mowers, light trucks, tractors, sprayers, pickups, and similar light automotive equipment;
- Continuance building of heavy equipment skills on the backhoe, loader, grader, and dozer;
- Mows ditches in clearing grass and weeds to insure proper water flow;
- Cleans pipelines and canals of debris;
- Performs repairs of fences, rights-of-ways and pipes

Qualifications:

Education – High School Graduate/Diploma

Experience: One year of successful performance at a general construction related job and demonstration of knowledge, skills, and abilities which would indicate a reasonable expectation of future successful performance at the journey level. Knowledge of agriculture and irrigation preferred.
